I am requesting funding for the Appleton International Airport Baggage Ticketing and Outbound Baggage in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Appleton International Airport, located at W6390 Challenger Drive, Appleton, Wisconsin 54914.

The funding would be used to expand and modernize Appleton International Airport's ticketing and baggage areas.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the expansion and modernization of Appleton International Airport's ticketing and baggage areas will have a significant positive impact on both the regional economy and the surrounding community. By increasing capacity and operational efficiency, the project will support the addition of a fifth airline, enhancing travel options and connectivity for residents and businesses.
