Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Village of Suamico's Water Infrastructure Improvement Project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Village of Suamico, located at 12781 Velp Avenue, Suamico, Wisconsin 54313.

The funding would be used to support the construction of a 300,000-gallon water tower that will store water from a new well the village plans to construct. The project also includes Hydrous Manganese Oxide treatment to improve water quality.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because investing in water infrastructure will not only ensure clean drinking water, but it will improve property values and benefit the local economy.

The project has a federal nexus because it is eligible for funding under the Community Development Fund account of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The requested funds will support the construction of a new municipal water tower that will directly enable residential and commercial development, promote economic growth, and expand access to essential infrastructure in alignment with the goals of the Economic Development Initiative (EDI) program. The project will improve water capacity and reliability, facilitating new housing opportunities and supporting long-term community development.
