I am requesting funding for the Village of Howard's Public Works Operations Facility Expansion Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Village of Howard, located at 2456 Glendale Ave, Green Bay, WI 54313.

The funding would be used to expand the Village of Howard's Public Works Operations Facility by adding approximately 26,000 square feet of vehicle storage, equipment maintenance space, and operational capacity needed to support essential municipal services.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because investing in core public works infrastructure improves service efficiency, protects public assets, and ensures the village can continue delivering reliable, cost-effective services to residents and businesses.

This project has a federal nexus because it is eligible for funding under the Economic Development Initiative (EDI) account within the Transportation, Housing and Urban Development, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, which authorizes federal assistance for public facilities and infrastructure improvements that support community development and economic growth. Expanding the Village of Howard Public Works Operations Facility aligns with this authority by strengthening essential municipal infrastructure systems that serve residents, businesses, and ongoing community development.
